In addition to this, 80% of the fund will be invested in "sustainable investments". These "sustainable investments" are companies that have been identified as having mature sustainable business practices that drive sustainable outcomes. The fund may also invest in companies that have emerging sustainable business practices that are expected to make growing contributions to sustainable outcomes in the coming years or companies that may not be engaged in activities that drive sustainable outcomes, but have strong management of ESG risks.</p>
